

Grassy Flats Charters Check Off List

What to bring on all Fishing Charters

- A great attitude! Willingness to learn and have fun!
- Hat (wide brim, one that will provide sun protection)
- Clothing that fits the weather conditions (it's best to layer, it may be cool early and late in the day). Rain gear is recommended during the summer months due to the showers that may develop, speak with the Captain before your trip.
- Sun glasses (If sight fishing polarized sun glasses are a must have. Tinted work the best with amber, copper, or vermilion lenses for the best visibility into the water)
- Comfortable non-marring shoes (Please, no black soles)
- Sun screen protection "lotion's and/or clothing" (don't forget your lips)
- Whatever you would like to drink or eat (please talk with the Captain before you go shopping)
- Camera / Video camera

What to bring on Sightseeing / Photo Excursions

Same as "fishing charters" but in addition you may want to include:

- Binoculars
- Spotting scope
- Umbrella for shade
- Snorkeling gear
- Towels

What to bring on the Crooked Island Sound "Do it all Excursion!"

Same as the other charters but **consider adding small beach chairs and a cooler**. It may make you're your trip a little more comfortable.
